<u>Groove</u>	Groove in Rockville, MD offers inclusive music, dance, and movement classes with adaptive coaching tailored to neurodiverse learners.
<u>SchoolTalk DC – InclusiveDC</u>	SchoolTalk’s InclusiveDC initiative in Washington, DC empowers neurodiverse youth through arts-based advocacy and career readiness programs, including the Arts to Advocacy workshops and Voices of Change conference.
<u>Imagination Stage</u>	Imagination Stage in Bethesda, MD offers Access Classes and the Pegasus Ensemble, a two-year actor training program designed specifically for students with cognitive, developmental, and physical disabilities.
<u>Adventure Theatre MTC</u>	Adventure Theatre MTC in Glen Echo, MD provides inclusive musical theatre training and performance opportunities for children and teens, with a commitment to equity and accessibility.
<u>Levine Music</u>	Levine Music provides inclusive music education and music therapy across five campuses in the DMV area, welcoming students of all abilities and offering scholarships to ensure access.
<u>The Kennedy Center</u>	The Kennedy Center in Washinton, DC provides inclusive arts education through performances and workshops. Their programs aim to uplift neurodiverse learners by recognizing disability as a cultural identity and fostering artistic growth.
<u>Wolf Trap</u>	Wolf Trap’s education programs in Vienna, VA include inclusive music and movement experiences for young children, with a focus on early childhood development and accessibility.
<u>Strathmore</u>	Strathmore in Rockville, MD features "relaxed house rules" and a "no-shush" environment for its Strathmore Kids events. The venue also offers sensory-friendly resources and pre-show materials.
